Jeremiah 17:5-8

Trusting God's Ways

If you resist God’s will, you are doomed. There are things you want. There are situations you wish would go your way. Sometimes you can arrange to make that happen. Sometimes other people suffer for it. Sometimes they benefit because your vision is actually quite good.

But sometimes your way is not God’s way. You may not agree with God’s way. You may think God is making a mistake. You may think your idea is better and that God should listen to you.

But God has a plan. It is a mysterious plan. It is a plan incomprehensible to humans. And sometimes God’s plan is not your plan.

“Cursed is the one who trusts in human beings, who seeks his strength in flesh,” God says through the prophet Jeremiah. Trust in anything that is not divine, and you will be a barren bush in the desert, standing in a lava waste, salt, and empty earth.

It will not be pretty.

But if you trust in God, you are blessed. You are like a tree planted beside waters with roots stretching to the stream. Your leaves will stay green. You will bear fruit even in drought.

But it may mean giving up the things you want and accepting what God wants.
